Purpose of Scholarship Program

The purpose of the MaxYield Cooperative scholarship program is to encourage area youth to pursue and prepare for careers in agriculture. This program is designed to provide financial assistance for students pursuing higher education in the field of agriculture.

Scholarship Amount

MaxYield will offer a maximum of **six \$1000 scholarships** to full-time students in pursuit of an agricultural degree. Scholarship applications and essays are due to MaxYield by March 1, 2019. (Postmarked or submitted online no later than March 1, 2019)

Scholarship Eligibility

1. **Applicant must be a MaxYield Cooperative client or a dependent of a MaxYield Cooperative client.**
2. Applicant must be a high school or college student enrolled in an agricultural degree.
3. **The applicant must complete the application form. Forms are sent to area guidance counselors and high schools, available on our web site, or may be picked up at any MaxYield location.**
4. **Applicants must submit a written essay with the application, no more than one page, entitled “Why I selected agriculture as my career.”**
5. **Applicants must submit a copy of your high school and/or college transcripts.**
6. Applicants must be enrolled as a full-time freshman, sophomore, or junior student at an accredited College, Trade School, or a high school graduating senior enrolling into the fall semester at an accredited College or Trade School.
7. Applicants must have cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 at a local high school or college.
8. **Maximum number of times a student can win the scholarship award is twice.**
9. The awarded scholarship will be applied toward tuition for Fall Semester.

Award Process

3. Scholarship winners will be personally notified of the award.
4. Financial Aid Department of applicable college will apply scholarship award toward tuition.

Scholarship Application

MaxYield Cooperative will award a maximum of six (6) scholarships of \$1000 to students in pursuit of an Agricultural Degree in two or four year college programs. Scholarship recipients will be awarded according to the following criteria: 1) review of submitted essay, 2) leadership potential, 3) good academic standing and 4) career goals/vision. Applicant must be a full-time student that has been or will be accepted into a college program that offers an agricultural degree or a two year transferable Ag program to go on and major in agricultural curriculum. Postmark deadline is March 1, 2019.
